Travelling to Jordan

Introduction:

Jordan NPC and Alatta will host Alatta Open International Goal ball Championship 2022 in Amman - Jordan.

They has the honor to pledge excellence in the preparation and organization this event with great care despite the challenging global COVID-19 pandemic. We also stand committed to ensure a successful tournament held at the highest standards of health and safety.

This document sets out the precautionary measures, safety and health protocols that will be taken during the tournament to ensure the safety of the participating delegations.

The tournament will take place from May 25 – 31 /2022 and will be fully accessible to participants to ensure a safe and friendly sporting environment. The participants are expected to be about 150 people including international delegates, and they are all expected to participate in the guiding principles of health and safety protocols during the event through an environment that aims to achieve the highest standards of risk prevention while minimizing the spread of disease.

All the protocols and procedures advised by the Jordanian Ministry of Health and stipulated of importance to health and safety in sporting events will be applied in the tournament, as the tournament venue will be fully equipped to meet the needs of all teams and the organizing committee will work with all teams to ensure a comfortable stay.

In the case of any positive COVID-19 at the venue, contingency measures will be taken by the organizing committee in coordination with team doctors to ensure the treatment and wellbeing of the infected persons.

Three procedures you need to do before entering Jordan:

- 1. PCR test 72 hours before departure origin country.**
- 2. Apply on <https://www.gateway2jordan.gov.io/form/> For every person and get a QR code.(Official Portal)**
- 3. PCR test when arriving Amman – Jordan.**

The PCR test should be done within maximum 72 hours prior to departure. - The passenger is required to apply on our portal, even if he has a vaccination certificate; the system will show what the requirements are based on the information provided by him while applying. www.gateway2jordan.gov.jo

Note: Even if you have a European green passport, you must do a PCR test before entering Jordan.

- Delegates who arrives at Queen Alia Airport are required to present the QR code they will receive from portal, a negative PCR test from the departure origin country, and the vaccination certificate if found printed out, when they check in at the airport counter.

In case of a positive result, the delegate/s must enter the quarantine for 7 days and take a (PCR) test (COVID19) on the seventh day of the quarantine at his own expense in the places determined by the local organizing committee later, and failure to comply with the quarantine requirements could result in legal prosecution under the Defense Order number 16.

PCR Tests for return:

For those who needs a PCR test for their return, the LOC will try to organize these tests at the hotel (on the participants cost). Most delegates will need this PCR test before two days leaving Jordan (72 hours).
