2. FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES

All participants in the event (managers, technicians, athletes) must respect and comply the rules of IBSA and IJF.

3. COMPETITION VENUE

4. COMPETITION RULES

The competitions will be conducted in accordance with the latest IBSA, IJR and IJF.

System of competition: **double repechage/robin round system.**

Duration of contest: **4 minutes.**

6. WEIGHT CATEGORIES (maybe the limits of weight categories can change)

- Men J 1 (Blind): -60 kg, -73 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg
- Men J 2 (Partially sighted): -60 kg, -73 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg
- Women J 1 (Blind): -48 kg, -57 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg
- Women J 2 (Partially sighted): -48 kg, -57 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg



7. ACCREDITATION

The control of entries and issuing of accreditation cards will take at the hotel.

The accreditation is completed by IBSA, ISAS and by the Judo Classification Master (IBSA website).

At least one team official must attend in time to confirm the entries of all athletes and officials with his/her signature. Athletes' passports (or photocopy) must be available on request.

Please note that the loss and replacement of accreditation cards will incur a fee of 30,00 Euro.

During the Championships, the LOC will use notice boards in the hotels and also digital applications to share information.

8. REFEREEING

The competitions will be refereed by International Referees (IJF A and B level with IBSA Judo license) selected by the IBSA Judo Referees Commission.

9. DRAW

The draw will be broadcast on-line. The link to go live will be communicated at a later time.

10. WEIGHT-IN AND RANDOM WHEIGHT-IN

The athletes must have their passports and ID cards for the weigh-in; ID card only is allowed for the random weigh-in.

11. JUDOGI CONTROL

Athletes must compete wearing an IJF approved judogi. The current list of manufactures can be seen on the IJF web site.

Each competitor is obliged to have sewn on the back of his/her judogi a backnumber bearing his surname and his/her National Olympic Committee abbreviation.

The local organisers will inspect the judogi size and validity, the backnumber and publicity that should comply with the current IBSA and IJF.

12. ANTIDOPING

Anti-doping procedures will be conducted according to the most recent COVID19 protocols:

13. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

Each athlete must be registered and licensed in the ISAS system before arrival.

For classification all athletes should be registered in the database and licensed 6 weeks before classification.

All participating countries must be in good standing with IBSA.



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14. INSCRIPTION CRITERIA

Participating athletes must be 15 years in the calendar year or older.

Each delegation can inscribe a maximum of two (2) athletes per weight category for the individual competition.

NB: Substitution (because of injuries, visa problems or all other reasons) of an athlete will only be allowed up to the deadline of the MDF upload i.e. six weeks before the first classification day. After that date NO substitutes will be allowed to participate.

15. DEADLINES

- Deadline of the Intention Form: **20th April 2022** (no payment requested)
- Deadline of the “Entry by numbers”: **10th June 2022** (first payment of 30% requested, not refundable).
- Deadline of the “Entry by names”: **15th July 2022** (total payment requested).

In the quota you will pay for the Competition Program all the Championships services are including, starting **from dinner of 30th August to breakfast of 5th September**. Any other day before 30th August or after 5th September 2022 will be considered and paid as extra from regular Entry Fee.

Any day less will not be discounted from the regular quota.

DURING COMPETITION PERIOD (from 30th August 5th September)

- Accommodation in **DOUBLE** (or **TRIPLE**) room for each participant is **1.120,00 Euro**.
- Accommodation in **SINGLE** room for each participant is **1.470,00 Euro**.

Additional to the quota as above:

- ❖ **25,00 Euro for IBSA Capitation Fee** (to be paid only for the athletes) collecting by the Organizing Committee.

DURING TRAINING CAMP PERIOD (from 5th September to 8th September):

- Accommodation in **DOUBLE** (or **TRIPLE**) room for each participant is **400,00 Euro**.
- Accommodation in **SINGLE** room for each participant is **550,00 Euro**.

The quota covers transportation services, accommodation, meals (from lunch of 5th to breakfast of 8th September).

It could be possible that a local **city tax of 2,00 Euro per person per day (up to 5 days)** will be charged by the Municipality and collected by the Organizing Committee; more info follows.

16. PAYMENT

1. The first 30% of the total entry fee is payable within **10th June 2022**. **NOT REFUNDABLE!**
2. The second payment of 70% of the entry fee must be paid within **15th July 2022**.

17. ACCOMMODATION

The best 4-star hotels maximum 15 minutes distant from the venue will be reserved for the Championship based on the total number of participants; the details about accommodation for each Delegation will be communicate at a later time.

Check in time: 16:00

Check out time: 10:00

Hotel reservations must be made through the Organizing Committee. **All delegates inscribed for an IBSA Judo official event must stay in one of the official hotels suggested by the organizers.** If this is not respected accreditation will not be given.

If rooms need to be cancelled please inform the organizer immediately.

Cancellation of rooms cannot be made at check-in. Illness, injuries or visa problems are not valid reasons for the cancellation of rooms. If rooms are cancelled the organizer has the right to charge the participating delegation as follows:

- The first payment of 30% is not refundable.
- Up to 20th July, 70% is refunded.
- No show is not refundable.

Any damage to hotel property resulting from the stay of a national delegation will be charged to the national federation and must be paid in full.

18. TRANSPORT

The organizer will provide free of charge transportation for competing delegations staying in official hotels during the Championships and training camp. This includes transport to and from the official hotels, accreditation, the draw, weigh-in, training and competition unless they are within walking distance.

For arrivals and departures, a transfer service is available to official hotels from

Travel information must be sent to the organizers by 15th July 2022 with the “Entry by Names”.



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19. CLASSIFICATION (Procedure for the classification of an athlete at a competition)

- A fully filled MDF, dated and signed by a certified ophthalmologist, must be uploaded in ISAS, **6 weeks before the first classification day of the event**. Only the current MDF (available for downloading from the IBSA website) is accepted.
- The MDF's will be thoroughly checked after they have been uploaded. Athletes without the correct MDF uploaded in due time will not be scheduled for classification and cannot enter the competition. **There will be no exceptions.**
- For athletes with a Review status, tests and complementary medical exams requested in previous competitions should be uploaded at the same time of MDF, 6 weeks before the first classification day of the event. If not, the athlete will be excluded from the competition.
- Each athlete should state in the MDF if they wear optical correction (glasses, contact lenses, filters) when they compete. If so and it was not STATED in the MDF form the athlete will be excluded from the competition.
- All athletes to be classified at an event need to be ready for classification at the first hour on the first day and rested especially if the travel has been long distance. Sleepy/tired people cannot cooperate well and they risk not to be classified. Late arrivals will not be considered for the Classification schedules.
- Only athletes competing in this event can be classified.

20. VISA TO THE NATIONAL TERRITORY

Countries requiring a visa must send a complete list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of birth and residence along with scanned copies of all passports prior to the established deadline to the following e-mail address: disardiniaolbia@gmail.com within **10th June 2022**.
