U 21: 2003-2006 maximum 2rd Kyu (blue belt)
U 18: 2006-2008
U 15: 2009-2011

Last date of registration: **04th january 2023**

Complete vaccination with European licenced Covid Vaccine necessary. PCR Test not older than 48 hours before entering Germany. Or recovered from Covid Infection. Daily Antigen Tests during tournament and Camp.

Starting Fee: 30,- € per participant. Payable cash before the weight out. Double after Dead Line. Non refundable.

Travel Expenses: All travel expenses, accommodation and food supply has to be paid by participants and/or delegations.

Protection regulations:

1. With the registration the associations and starting communities ensure the match ability of their athletes.
2. All participants must be in the possession of a valid sport health and starting passport
3. The sport health certificates must be shown to the competition office before the official beginning. The last medical examination in the sport health certificate may not be older than 6 months (counted from the last day of the competition).

Participants which do not fulfill these conditions are losing their starting rights. Foreign participants must be in the possession of an appropriate medical permission of an disabled athletes federation or the international starting passport

Doping:

Doping is not permitted according to the anti-doping regulations of the IBSA. With registration the participants declare the acknowledgement of the anti-doping regulations of the IBSA.

For this reason all participants have to carry a listing of the taken medicines with medical indication, in order to be able to submit this list if necessary. If this indication proof is missing, the athlete can be punished in the case of a positive result.

Athletes who need substances for medical indication which are listed of the WADA – Prohibited list have to exhibit a Therapeutic use Exemption (TUE)

Controls are accomplished in a random sampling way.

Liability:

The DBS and its organs are responsible for accidents only within the borders of the existing liability insurance protection. The liability for accidents going beyond it is expressly excluded. The insurance contract can be seen at any time in the DBS office.

Requirements from the sport accident insurances of the national sport federations or of the DBS are not affected by this limitation of liability.

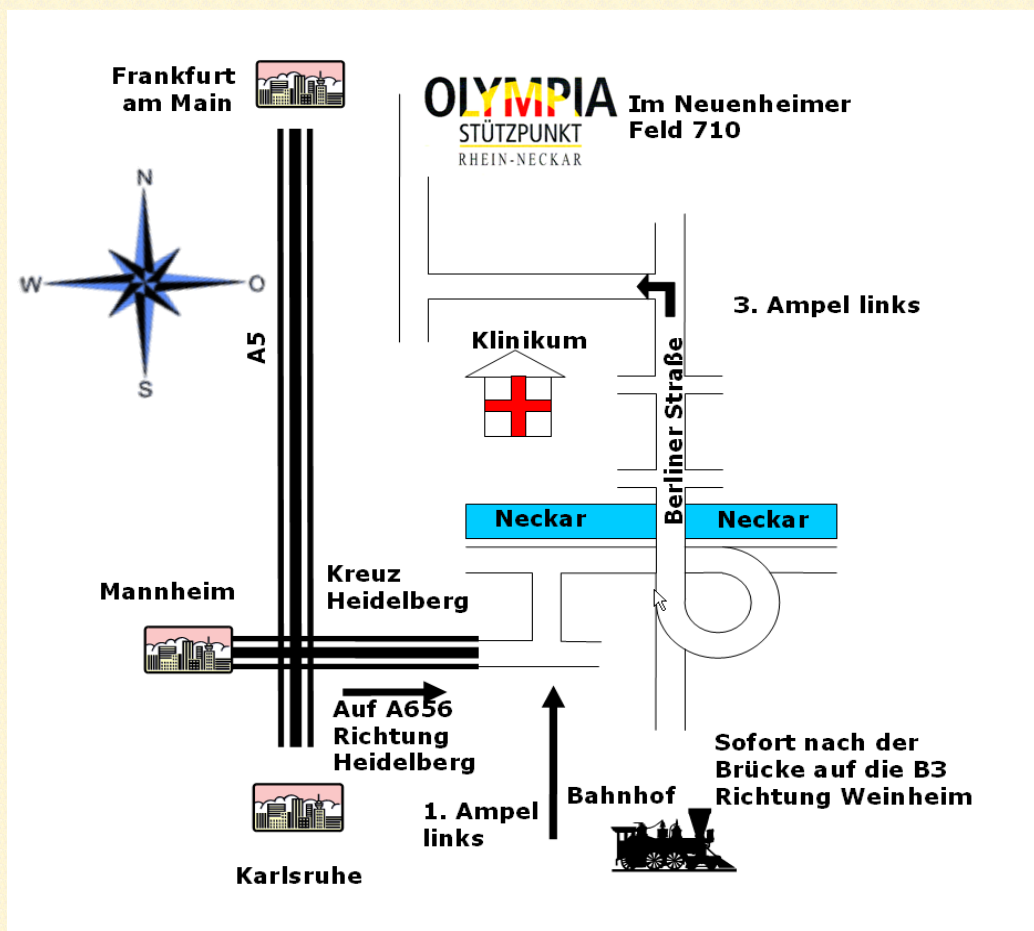

By bus: Take the bus “line 32” from main station to “Studentenwohnheim”. Then change to bus “line 37 – Olympiastützpunkt Rhein-Neckar”.

**Health restrictions by German Natational Paralympic Committee.
Valid from 01st October 2022. Any changes will be communicated by Mail
direct to all registered nations.**

Every member of the event needs minimum 3 vaccination by a Vaccine licenced from EMA, or is recovered from a Covid Sars 2 infection. In addition you need an Antigen Test not older then 24 hours or a PCR Test not older than 48 hours to enter Germany.

Rules for the WRL Points Semi – sanctioned Competitions by IBSA.

Each athlete (adults) needs a valid eye classification

Event must be visited by 8 – 10 countries

There is no limit of judokas per weight categories, but only the best two of a nation can provide points.

1st = 70 points

2nd = 50 points

3rd = 40 points

4th = 30 points

5th = 20 points

7th = 10 points

Participation = 1 point
