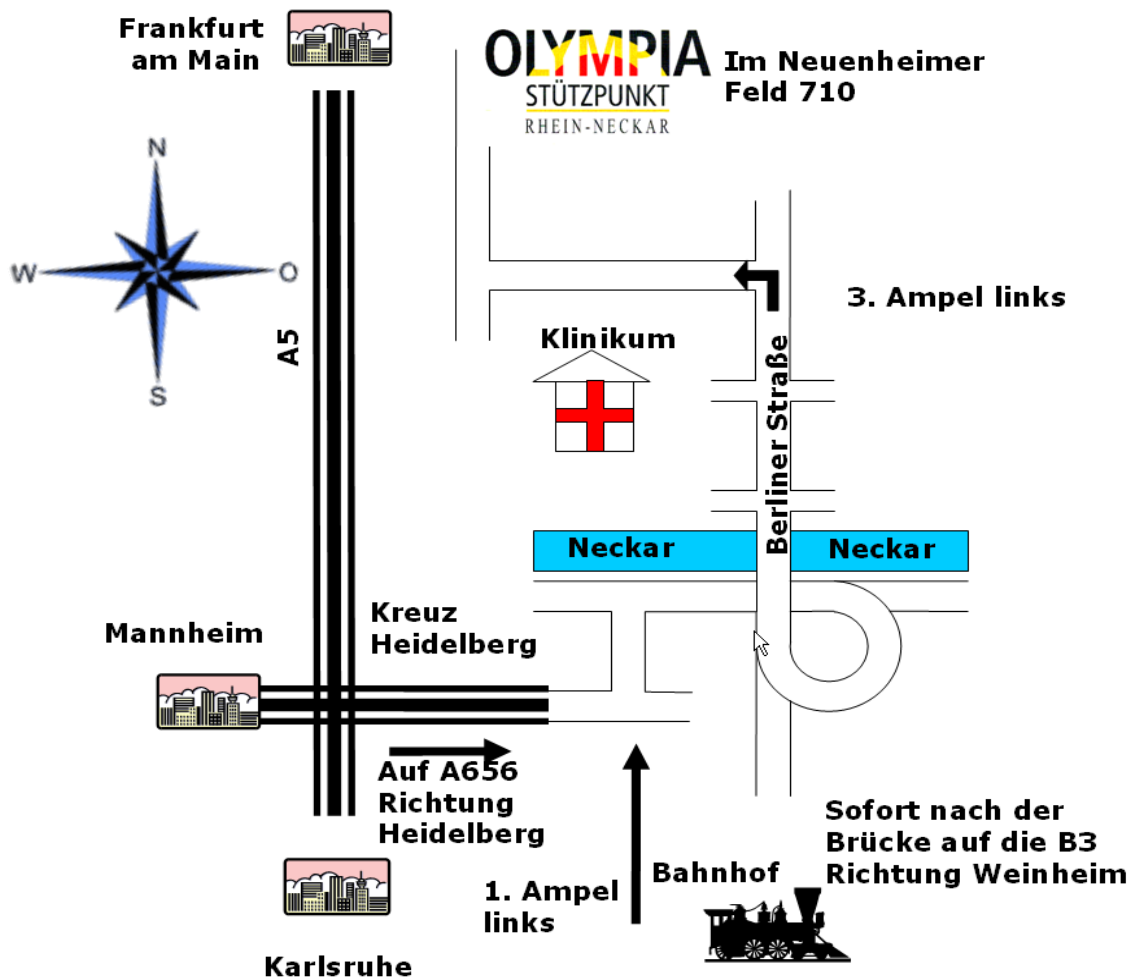

By car: At the end of highway "A 656" follow the sign "Olympiastützpunkt Rhein-Neckar"



By tram and bus: 1. Take the tram „line 24“ from main station to “Technologiepark”. Then change to bus “line 37 – Olympiastützpunkt Rhein-Neckar”.

2. Take the bus “line 32” from main station to “Jugendherberge”. Then change to bus “line 37 – Olympiastützpunkt Rhein-Neckar”.

Health restrictions by German Natational Paralympic Committee.

Valid from 01st October 2022. Any changes will be communicated by Mail direct to all registered nations.

Every member of the event needs minimum 3 vaccination by a Vaccine licenced from EMA, or is recovered from a Covid Sars 2 infection. In addition you need an Antigen Test not older then 24 hours or a PCR Test not older than 48 hours to enter Germany.

Rules for the WRL Points Semi – sanctioned Competitions by IBSA.

Each athlete (adults) needs a valid eye classification

Event must be visited by 8 – 10 countries

There is no limit of judokas per weight categories, but only the best two of a nation can provide points.

Four best athletes on WRL on each weight category are seeded, if present.

Pont Chart: will be introduced by IPC at Judo Guide for Paris 2024.

1st = 70 points

2nd = 50 points

3rd = 40 points

4th = 30 points

5th = 20 points

7th = 10 points

Participation = 1 point
