- The Organizing Committee may make changes based on the number of athletes registered.

IMPORTANT REMARKS

- A judogi pre-control will be held on the 29th at the official hotel. This control is compulsory for all the athletes, who must be present at the established deadline with the white and blue judogis that they will use in the competition, as well as the belt.
- The official weigh-in for the second day of competition will take place in the sport hall at 14:00 h.
- The women's J1 -57 kg category will be contested on the second day of competition, 31 January.

ACCREDITATION

The control of entries and issuing of accreditation cards will take at the hotel.

The accreditation is completed by IBSA, ISAS and by the Judo Classification Master (IBSA website).

At least one team official must attend in time to confirm the entries of all athletes and officials with his/her signature. Athletes' passports (or photocopy) must be available on request.

REFEREEING

The competitions will be refereed by International Referees (IJF A with IBSA Judo license) selected by the IBSA Judo Referees Commission from the highest level of IJF referees.

DRAW

The draw will be broadcast on-line. The link to go live will be communicated at a later time. The best four athletes are seeded by weight categories.



WEIGHT-IN AND RANDOM WHEIGHT-IN

The athletes must have their passports and ID cards for the weigh-in; ID card only is allowed for the random weigh-in.

JUDOGI CONTROL

Athletes must compete wearing an IJF approved judogi. The current list of manufactures can be seen on the IJF web site. Each competitor is obliged to have sewn on the back of his/her judogi a backnumber bearing his surname and his/her National Olympic Committee abbreviation.

The local organisers will inspect the judogi size and validity, the backnumber and publicity that should comply with the current IBSA and IJF.

It is mandatory to use red circle on the back number for all J1 athletes. In the lack of a red circle, the coach doesn't sit in the coaching box (except of the new J1 athletes).

ANTIDOPING

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

Each athlete must be registered and licensed for 2023 in the ISAS system before arrival.

For classification all athletes should be registered in the database and licensed 6 weeks before classification.

All participating countries must be in good standing with IBSA.

INSCRIPTION CRITERIA



Participating athletes must be 15 years in the calendar year or older. Each delegation can inscribe a maximum of two (2) athletes per weight category for the individual competition.

All athletes must be licensed for 2023 and countries must have paid their membership fee for 2023.

NB: Substitution (because of injuries, visa problems or all other reasons) of an athlete will only be allowed up to the deadline of the MDF upload i.e. six weeks before the first classification day. After that date NO substitutes will be allowed to participate.

DEADLINES

Deadline of the entry by numbers: **2nd of December**.

Deadline of the entry by names: **17th of December - six weeks** before the first day of the competition, according to IBSA rules, to be able to arrange eye classification and the appropriate organization of the competition.

Entry forms after the deadline are not acceptable and it would mean that the IBSA Member cannot enter their team in the competition. It is mandatory to manage the entry of athletes using the IBSA ISAS database: <https://isas.ibsasport.org/isas/entries/index>

During the competition days (30th-31st of January) lunch will be served at the competition venue. There will be no lunch at the hotel during the competition days (30th-31st of January).

Hotel reservations must be made through the Organizing Committee.

All delegates inscribed for an IBSA Judo official event must stay in one of the official hotels suggested by the organizers. If this is not respected accreditation will not be given.

If rooms need to be cancelled, please inform the organizer immediately. Cancellation of rooms cannot be made at check-in. Illness, injuries or visa problems are not valid reasons for the cancellation of rooms. If rooms are cancelled the organizer has the right to charge the participating delegation as follows:

- Up to 30 days before the arrival - full refund.
- From 30-10 days before the arrival - 50% refund.
- From 9 – expected arrival - no refund, 100% of the hotel costs must be paid.

Reservations of extra rooms at the check-in may be surcharged with an additional 10%. Delegations are kindly requested not to dry clothing (including judogi) or have training sessions in the corridors of the official hotels. Any damage to hotel property resulting from the stay of a national delegation will be charged to the national federation and must be paid in full.

TRANSPORT

The organizer will provide free of charge transportation for competing delegations staying in official hotels during the Championships and training camp. This includes transport to and from the official hotels, accreditation, the draw, weigh-in, training and competition unless they are within walking distance.

For arrivals and departures, a transfer service is available to official hotels from:

- **Aeroporto Humberto Delgado (LIS)**

Travel information must be sent to the organizers by **5th of January**.

CLASSIFICATION (PROCEDURE FOR THE CLASSIFICATION OF AN ATHLETE AT A COMPETITION)

Classification will take place the **27 and 28 January** (full days), and eventually on the **29** morning

- A fully filled MDF dated, checked and signed by the National Federation and a certified ophthalmologist, must be uploaded in ISAS, in pdf format, **6 weeks before** (17 December) **the first classification day of the event**. Only the current new **JUDO MDF** (available for downloading from the IBSA website) is accepted.
- The MDF's will be thoroughly checked after they have been uploaded. Athletes without the correct MDF uploaded **and** in due time, will not be scheduled for classification and cannot enter the competition. **There will be no exceptions.**
- For athletes with **CNC** or a **Review** status, tests and complementary medical exams with less than 1 year old, requested in previous competitions should be uploaded at the same time of MDF, 6 weeks before the first classification day of the event (17 December) . If not, the athlete will be **automatically** excluded from the Classification schedule without the MDF checked and no feedback send. Athlete cannot compete. After 3 consecutive CNC the athlete will be Non Eligible. **There will be no exceptions.**



- Each athlete should state in the MDF if they wear optical correction (glasses, contact lenses, filters) when they compete. If so and it was not STATED in the MDF form the athlete will be excluded from the competition.
- All athletes to be classified at an event need to be ready for classification **at the first hour on the first day and rested**, especially if the travel has been long distance. Sleepy/tired people cannot cooperate well and they risk not to be classified. Late arrivals will not be considered for the Classification schedules.
- Only athletes competing in this event can be classified.
- **All countries must use the new Judo MDF, in pdf format, for athletes who need to be classified.**

TRAINING CAMP

VENUE: TBC

DATE: 1st to 2nd of february.

The price for one person per night including the full board (sauna, fitness, swimming pool) will be:

- Single 130 EUR (full board)
- Twin 100 EUR (full board, per person per night)

Transfer from the official hotel to the training camp and after the end of the camp to the airport also will be provided.
