



Team competition regulations for 2023

Tournaments:

Tournaments which include a team competition in 2023: Amber of Liepaja, Prague Open.

For the team competition to be played, there should be a minimum number of 4 teams at the tournament.

Playing system:

All games are played in one day, which is two days before the start of the individual competition.

If there are 4 or 5 teams, the round Robin principle is applied.

For 6 to 11 teams, the teams are divided into two groups. Best 2 teams of each group advance to the play-offs (semi finals and final).

If there are 12+ teams, the teams are divided into at least 3 groups. Each group consists of at least 4 teams. The quarter finals are introduced to the playing system.

Teams:

Teams consist of a minimum 3 players, maximum 6 players. (If 3-4 players, at least 1 player of each gender; 5-6 players, at least 2 players of each gender).

One player of each gender must always be in the playing rotation.

A team can consist of players from different countries.

A team has a name, which does not change during the playing season (year).

Every team has a team principal, a player or a coach, who has the rights to the team name during the season (year) and he/she registers the team to every tournament. This person does not have to be necessarily present in every tournament.

The team can not change players during one tournament.

One player can represent only one team during the tournament.

One player is not allowed to represent more than 2 teams during one season (year).

Ranking points:

There is a separate ranking from the individual events.

The ranking points are awarded to the team (team name) independent of the players that represent it:

Ranking system:

1st	20 points
2nd	16 points
3rd	12 points
4th	10 points
5th	9 points
6th	8 points
7th	7 points
8th	6 points
9th	5 points
10th	4 points
11th	3 points
12th	2 points
13th	1 point
14th etc	0 points
